**Directions to Nursery by Car**

**From South Jersey**

North on the Garden State Parkway (Local Lanes) to Exit #114. At traffic light turn left onto Red Hill Road. Go past next traffic light. After light, go to 3<sup>rd</sup> driveway on right side (#123), and turn right into Nursery. Call (732) 946-9797 or (732) 546-5410 (cell) for assistance and service.

**From North Jersey**

South on the Garden State Parkway (Local Lanes) to Exit #114. At traffic light turn right onto Red Hill Road. Go to 3<sup>rd</sup> driveway on right side (#123), and turn right into Nursery. Call (732) 946-9797 or (732) 546-5410 (cell) for assistance and service.

**Directions to Nursery by Truck**

**Truck Route From South Jersey**

New Jersey Turnpike to Exit #8 Hightstown. Go onto Route #33 East toward downtown Freehold. Turn left onto Route #9 North, follow Route 9 North till Route #520. Turn right onto Route #520 and follow Route #520 until Route #34. Turn left onto Route #34. Proceed 1 mile and turn right onto Roberts Road. Follow Roberts Road till reaching end (3 miles) and turn right onto Crawfords Corner Road. Proceed on Crawford Corners Road to 1<sup>st</sup> traffic light. Turn left on Red Hill Road - 3<sup>rd</sup> driveway on left side (#123 is marked on the fence) is Red Hill Nursery. You will have to back into driveway and may need help, so call ahead to: (732) 946-9797 or (732) 546-5410 (cell) for assistance and service.

**Truck Route From North Jersey**

New Jersey Turnpike to Exit #11. Go South on Route #9. Go over Edison bridge, follow Route 9 South. Go thru Old Bridge. Turn left onto Route #34 South, go thru Matawan and 5-6 miles past Matawan, look for Roberts Road on left side. Turn left onto Roberts Road. Follow Roberts Road till reaching end (3 miles) and turn right onto Crawfords Corner Road. Proceed on Crawford Corners Road to 1<sup>st</sup> traffic light. Turn left on Red Hill Road - 3<sup>rd</sup> driveway on left side (#123 is marked on the fence) is Red Hill Nursery.
